- MOE's goal is for 20% of schools to be carbon neutral by 2030
- In line with MOE's and schools' focus on sustainability in areas of curriculum, campus infrastructure, culture and community
- Empower students to be advocates of sustainability through experience, engagement and activism
- To facilitate positive environmental outcomes and impact

What the Programme Entails:

12-month programme from July 2023 to July 2024:-

1. **A roving exhibition** of our e-bus, across schools about sustainable transportation with hands-on interactive learning
2. **Green journeys** to our eco-partners destinations for eco experiences
3. **Inter-school Eco Challenge** based on what was learnt from eco experiences



1. Roving Exhibition:- 'Driving the Future'

- The roving exhibit will enable students to learn about sustainable transportation
- Self-guided exhibition panels, AR content, carbon calculator and quiz to present an engaging experience
- Students will be encouraged to **take a pledge** to support green commuting
- YT's e-bus will be present for ½ day
- 5 school days
- From 27 June to 30 Apr 2024

2. Green Journeys eco experiences with our partner network

- Our eco-partners will provide hands-on experiences as part of green journeys that schools can register for:-
 - Venue: Tzu Chi Humanistic Youth Centre
 - Partners: Terra SG, Circular Asia
 - Hands-on learning of urban farming, upcycling of plastics and fabrics
 - Total: 1.5 hours
 - Starting from Jul 2023 to Feb 2024
- Schools can send up to 20 students who will be the eco warriors to go through the experience and bring it back as a project that they can carry out in their respective schools
- Multiplier effect of positive change to the larger school cohort
- Active advocacy and measurable impact & outcomes

3. Interschool Eco Challenge - Actionable component

- Students from participating schools who undergo the eco experience will take on the challenge of implementing the experience in their own school
- The process and outcome will then be documented in a video submission as part of the Eco Challenge
- Rubrics include the environmental goals reached and impact created, how the project has contributed to sustainability in the school, creativity and video quality
- Videos will be uploaded to a YouTube channel where they will form a repository of resources for peer learning

Deadline: by 31 July 2024



Interschool Eco Challenge

Examples of Rubrics

1. Measurable Environmental Impact:

- xx kg of food waste saved (composting)
- xx kg of produce harvested
- xx kg of plastics upcycled
- xx kg of fabrics upcycled

2. Creativity

- Demonstrates creative and original ideas for implementation of eco project
- Overcoming of any difficulties in implementation
- Creative story-telling and delivery of video

3. Contribution to school sustainability

- Outreach numbers (e.g. class / level / school)
- Adoption of green practices

4. Video Quality

- Production quality of the video

5. Social Impact (Secondary schools)

- Did the eco project benefit the community beyond the school

Outreach: 20 Primary & 20 Secondary schools to participate



1. Roving Exhibition:- June to Feb 2024
2. Green Journeys:- Jul 2023 to Feb 2024
3. Interschool Eco Challenge: Submissions by end July 2024

Schools must agree to participate in all 3 parts of the programme

You have the freedom to choose the order that works best for you. For example, you can go on the learning journey to the youth centre first and have the exhibition at your school later.
